Opera51's talented musicians are eagerly preparing two live performances of Mozart's delightful and enduringly popular opera "The Magic Flute". These will be held Saturday and Sunday August 14 and 15 at 51 Walden in Concord. Set in ancient Egypt, the story includes by turns stretches of drama, comedy, tragedy, requited love, buffoonery, not to mention mysticism, perfectly matched with lilting melodies, crisp orchestrations, the famous Queen of the Night aria, and Papageno's signature pan flute. No wonder this gem has delighted audiences continuously since 1791. Presented in concert version (not staged) with full orchestra and sung in German with projected English titles, this is a fundraiser to bolster the operating budget of The Performing Arts Center at 51 Walden.
